

# Insurance by special agreement

Extension of non-occupational accident insurance under the Federal Accident Insurance Act (UVG) of 20 March 1981

## Insurance against non-occupational accidents

If you work an average of at least eight hours a week for an employer, you are also insured by law against non-occupational accidents. This applies for as long as you are entitled to at least 50% of your salary, and ends on the 31st day after this entitlement ceases.

## Insurance by special agreement as an extension

If you give up paid employment either permanently or temporarily (for unpaid leave, for example), or if you reduce your working hours to fewer than eight per week, you can extend your insurance cover for up to six months by taking out insurance by special agreement. This means that you continue to enjoy all of the benefits payable under the Accident Insurance Act (UVG). You must take out this insurance with the provider with which you previously had mandatory cover for non-occupational accidents via your employer.

## It couldn't be easier:

Simply complete the payment slip shown below. Your monthly premium is CHF 25 (this applies to both full and partial months). To extend your insurance cover, the premium for the time you wish to be insured must be paid no later than the day on which your insurance for non-occupational accidents ends. If you are late transferring the premium, your insurance cover cannot be extended. The receipt for payment also functions as your confirmation of insurance.

## Other things you should know:

- The insurance by special agreement ends as soon as you return to working for more than eight hours a week for one employer. If you have overpaid premiums, they will not be reimbursed. You should therefore take out insurance by special agreement only for the period for which you are sure that you need it. If necessary, this insurance can be extended for up to six consecutive months if arranged before the end of the insurance term that has already been paid for.
- Insurance by special agreement is suspended if you are subject to military insurance, for example while attending a refresher course or civil defence course. Cover will then be extended by the corresponding period of time.
- If you need insurance cover for more than six months, please contact your health insurance provider.
